## NEW BLUES RELEASES

Delmark Records recently announced a number of new recordings including a new outing by Dave Weld & the Imperial Flames titled Burnin' Love. Lil' Ed makes a guest appearance playing rhythm guitar on a number of cuts plus vocal duties on "Ed's Boogie". The street date for Burning Love is April 20.

Additional new offerings from Delmark include a Mississippi Heat CD called Let's Live It UP featuring long time leader Pierre Lacocque and special guests John Primer and Carl Weathersby plus Willie Buck's The Life I Love. Both will be available by April 20.

Delmark will also reissue material originally recorded in the 80's by Jimmy Dawkins own label Leric Records. Most titles came out on 45 including work by Tail Dragger, Queen Sylvia Embry, Little Johnny Christian and others. First to appear in June will be Jimmy Dawkins Presents The Leric Story featuring some of the 80's 45's plus unissued work by Big Mojo Elem and more.

New albums from the Blind Pig label out of Chicago include John Nemeth's Name the Day, Stand Together by Harper plus a new outing by one of the Doc's all time favorites Magic Slim and the Teardrops called Raising the Bar. Over the years Magic Slim has set that bar pretty high - even for himself. Look for all of the above coming soon to your favorite record!

Underground Records out of Seattle, WA has a slew of recent offerings from West Coast artists. Becki Sue & her Big Rockin' Daddies just put out Big Rockin' Boogie - she had me at "Boogie". Others recent releases by Underground include Free Your Mind by Too Slim and the Taildraggers and Jim Suhler & Monkey Beats Tijuana Bible.
